CATEGORY C Bus Service - \$550 per annum – MYKI BUS INTO COLLEGE

*This is a School Special Bus that operates **under the following conditions:** -*

- This is a hybrid public bus that is provided by PTV that only carries Padua students.
- Bus is licenced for standing capacity, once seats are filled, standing is permitted.
- Students will be allocated based on legal capacity.
- Bus route cannot be altered.
- Bus comes into College grounds for drop off and pick up
- MYKI card is required to get on this bus.
- Eligible students are those who a) live more than 4.8km from their Campus and b) attend their nearest Padua Campus/Catholic school appropriate to their year level.
- If vacant places exist, a non-eligible student residing closer than 4.8km or one who attends a campus that is not their nearest can be allocated a place but will not be entitled to a MYKI reimbursement.
